Question 45: Why do we love and serve our neighbors	
A: We love and serve our neighbors as a sign of the kingdom of God. We do good works not to prove our goodness or earn salvation, but as the overflow of God's love working in and through us. Matt. 5:44-48; Rom. 13:9; James 2:8-9	August: Galatians/Ephesians Read the weekly Psalm passage in advance of Sunday
