GOSPEL WAY CATECHISM – Part 6 – THE PEOPLE OF GOD	Church Bible Reading Plan
Question 46: What is worship?	August: Galatians/Ephesians
A: Worship is the devotion we offer up to whatever we love most. Everyone worships. Christian worship is a lifelong outpouring of love to God, in humble adoration. Entranced by His beauty, we exalt Him through praise, trust, and obedience. John 4:23-34; Rom. 12:1-2; Heb. 12:28-29	Read the weekly Psalm passage in advance of Sunday

- *True worship begins with brokenness and humility over whatever God reveals to us in His Word. Poverty of spirit and mourning over our sin lead to genuine repentance, which in turn leads to forgiveness. Forgiveness will produce freedom – freedom from guilt and bondage. When we have freedom that has been birthed out of brokenness, repentance, and forgiveness, we will have a greater capacity for love – supernatural ability to love God and to love those who are unlovable – and for worship. And of course, true love and worship will lead up back to a new level of brokenness, which leads to greater and deeper repentance, increased forgiveness, newfound freedom, and an even greater capacity for love and for worship.* ~ Nancy Leigh DeMoss
